Webmaster Help

Are your club emails going to your Junk/Spam folder?

I have been hearing from several members having the problem of club emails going to their spam folder, especially the mail with Zoom meeting links. Most email systems have a function called “Whitelist” where you can add the address of a sender so it always is delivered to your inbox, though this feature is not always easy to find, and each provider seems to implement it in a different way. The thing to do is to do a Google search with the term Whitelist and the name of your email provider, in the results you should find some instructions on how to do it. Using the facility, add info@mpotac.com to the list of “safe” senders.


